Subject: *Report from the 12th International Scientific Conference "Anthropological and Theoanthropological Perspectives on Physical Activities"*

*The Faculty of Sports and Physical Education of the University of Priština in Kosovska Mitrovica, the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports of the University of East Sarajevo, the Faculty of Sports and Physical Education of the University of Niš, FIEPS Serbia and the Association Sport for All Serbia organized the **12th INTERNATIONAL SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE** "Anthropological and theoanthropological view of physical activities". **The topics of the conference were** theoretical, philosophical, medical, methodological and methodical aspects of research on physical activities in physical education, sports, recreation and kinesitherapy.*

The conference was held from 20-22.03.2025. on Kopaonik in the congress hall "Josif Pančić" of the Hotel "Grand" and the congress hall "JAT Apartments". The Scientific Conference began with the intonation of the anthem of the Republic of Serbia and the anthem Gaudeamus Igitur.

The Conference protocol was led by Prof. Dr Veroljub Stanković and after his introductory comments, he was the first to address the gathering personally. On behalf of the co-organizers, the Dean of the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports of the University of East Sarajevo, Prof. Dr Boroslav Cicović, addressed the gathering. On behalf of the patron of the Conference, FIEPS, the Vice President of the World Federation of Physical Education and Sports, Prof. Dr Branislav Antala, addressed the gathering. The Conference was opened by Prof. Dr Branislav Antala, Vice President of the World FIEPS.

The opening ceremony was attended by distinguished professors, deans, vice-deans, colleagues, students and the vice-rector of the State University in Novi Pazar, Prof. Dr Milovan Bratić, deans, vice-deans and representatives of the Faculties of Sport and Physical Education of the Universities of Niš, Veliko Tarnovo, Bacau, Banja Luka, Galati, Ljubljana, Skopje, Pristina, the Faculty of Pedagogy in Jagodina, representatives of the Faculties in Novi Sad, Alpha University, Shandong, Belgrade and Rome, the Higher School of Sports and Health in Belgrade, the University of Almeria, the University of Komotini, the University of Bucharest, professional sports organizations, the Ski Resorts of Serbia, as well as a large

number of Conference participants.

The International Conference took place in the Congress Center of the Hotel "GRAND", while the second and third days (sessions for young researchers) were held in the Congress Hall of the "JAT Apartments" and over the two days it was attended by about 180 registered participants, including a large number of professors, assistants and students. During the Conference, a meeting of the editorial board of the journal "Physical Education and Sport through the Ages" was held, as well as a FIEPS meeting.

At the session for young researchers, which was organized for the second time, a total of 23 papers were submitted, of which 12 were presented, which is 68.18%. The moderator of that session was Assoc. Prof. Dr Igor Ilić.

The moderators of the Conference were Prof. Dr Veroljub Stanković, Prof. Dr Toplica Stojanović, Prof. Dr Borislav Cicović, Prof. Dr Dušan Mitić; Assoc. Prof. Dr Igor Ilić and Assist. Prof. Dr Radenko Arsenijević

The Conference was closed by Prof. Dr Veroljub Stanković, President of the Organizing Committee.

83 papers were submitted to the Conference, of which 8 were invited lectures and 2 were workshops. A total of 43 papers were presented orally, which is 51.80% of the papers. This year, the Faculty also applied for financial funds from the Ministry of Science, Technological Development and Innovation.

*The main part of the Conference was for the second time Erasmus-BIP under the title **Student communication through sports activities and science in winter resorts** with participants from 7 universities from 6 countries with a total number of 47 participants (35 students and 12 professors).*

This year, the website and the conference acronym "ATAVPA" were updated for this Conference at the address ATAVPA (fsfv-pr.rs), through which all communication, notification and issuance of certificates to all participants are carried out. And most importantly, we collected metadata of all papers through the platform.

The Faculty received a large number of sincere compliments, a large number of meetings were held with colleagues from abroad, and further cooperation was agreed upon. This scientific conference received the highest marks from all guests for its high scientific-academic, professional and organizational level. The idea was supported that the Conference "Anthropological and Theoanthropological View of Physical Activities" should continue to be held every year at the same place and, we hope, grow into a Congress as early as 2026.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all the co-organizers of the Conference for their selfless help in organizing this, for all of us, important scientific and professional event.
